ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2016-17

A BRIEF REPORT

1. Computers, printers, scanners, UPS and dongle for net connectivity were purchased from the grants received for IQAC (UGC fund). The website was also upgraded.
2. Meetings of all the committees of college were organized regularly for all round development of the college.
3. Internal assessments were conducted in all the programmes in the direction of examination committee. Seminars in all the programmes of PG semester classes were also conducted.
4. All the departments made their departmental profile to record the biodata of teachers, seminars, research papers, projects, syllabus and activities of associations and achievement of students.
5. The career counseling cell of the college organized two programmes for the counselling of students on 08/10/2016 and 10/11/2016 by the aid of resource persons of coaching classes. Four students of the college got placement in different services. Pramila Kanwar student of M.A. Economic passed SLET examination.
6. CCTV cameras were installed at different places of the college to monitor the security of students and the institution.
7. UGC Minor Research Project with total outlay of Rs. 4.87Lakhs was awarded to DR. M.M. Vaishnav, Asstt. Prof of chemistry, Dr. Mahesh Kumar Verma, Asstt. Prof. Maths was awarded Ph.d. Degree in the session.
8. Some of the teachers participated in seminars and workshops organized by RUSA and NAAC at different venues.
9. Many extension and outreach programmes such as seven days camp, health camp, blood donation, tree plantation, cleanliness, voter awareness, environment day, yoga day, world aids day, youth day etc were organized by the NSS unit and Youth Red Cross of the college. 264 patients got free treatment and medicines in the health camp on 07/11/2016, at village Andikachhar.
10. 437 Tablets were distributed to UG/PG final students under the scheme of Yuva Sanchar Kranti Yojna of Chhattisgarh Govt.
11. One more unit of water cooler with RO facility was provided in the science faculty of the college.
12. One student of MSC Botany got gold medal in the merit list of the university. Two students of BSC got 3rd rank in the merit list of university.
13. Dr. M.M. Vaishnav published 03 research papers in prestigious journals recognized by UGC. One Asstt. Professor of Hindi department participated in Orientation Programme at Guru Ghasidas Central University Bilaspur (C.G.)
14. One volunteer of NSS, Ku. Priyanka Rani Dhari participated in Blue Brigade Training programme from 24/06/2016 to 30/06/2016 in Raipur.

ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2017-18

A BRIEF REPORT

6. Result of all UG classes has improved a lot, but the result of PG classes was not good enough compared to the last session. These students are required to focus much more on their self study and group discussion.
7. The career counseling cell organized two sessions for the career development of students on 10/10/2017 and 12/11/2017 by different resources persons. In the first programme 114 students and in the second 69 students got training. Dr. Pyarelal Adile, Principal, JBD college Katghora delivered a lecture on modern competitive examination system on 12/09/2017.
8. 03 Students of the college, Pramila Kanwarr, Sanjeev Kumar, Asha Sahu passed NET test in this session. Mr. Sanjeev Kumar Rathore got placement as an Asstt. Prof. Chemistry.
9. The department of Botany organized educational tour and field study programme in the session.
10. In sports, 03 students of the college, Parmeshwar Yadav, Krishna Kaiwart and Ku. Shashi got gold medal in different athletics competitions.
11. Dr. M.M. Vaishnav, Asstt. Prof. Chemistry and Dr. K.K. Dubey Asstt. Prof. Physics were appointed examiners in the State Public Service Commission of Chhattisgarh.
12. NSS unit of the college organized seven day camp in village Mangamar from 31/10/2017 to 06/11/2017 to aware society in various fields. It also organized legal literacy programme during the camp. Red Cross unit organized a health camp in collaboration with Dipka Dispensary at Mangamar village with free check up and free medicines for 68 Villagers. One student Lalit Porte participated in state NSS camp and National camp in this session.
13. The associations of all the departments organized programmes on State Foundation Day, Gandhi Jayanti, Republic Day, Saraswati Pooja, Welcome/Farewell Programmes.
14. 07 research papers in Chemistry by Dr. M. M. Vaishnav, 02 research papers in Chemistry by Dr. S.K. Murthy and 05 research papers in Maths by Dr. M. K. Verma were published in the session.
15. The college had a long demand for CC road up to college. 600mts CC approach road was built from college chowk to college gate from the fund provided by local MLA Shri Lkhan Lal Dewangan Ji.

ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2018-19

A BRIEF REPORT

1. Annual result of all the programmes except PG in Geography, Chemistry and Botany was found up to the mark. Result of B.A., B.Sc. and B.COM was excellent. Result in PG programmes of Economics, Sociology and English was 100%. All necessary steps to improve results were taken.
2. Damaged roof sheets of classrooms and broken furniture were repaired. Drinking water facility was improved in the college premises. Facility of fans and lights in all the classroom was improved. White washing of all the teaching rooms, labs and departments was done. Green boards were provided in all the class rooms.

ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2019-20

A BRIEF REPORT

1. Annual result of all the programmes was analysed. Result of the most of the UG/PG programmes was above 90% to the great satisfaction of IQAC initiatives. Only the result outcome of PG Sociology and Physics was lacking behind. Provisions to improve these results were also discussed.
2. Action was taken regarding renovation of the girls hostel, Community Hall, sports hall and computer room. Regular water supply was provided in the girls hostel by installing a submersible pump. Tiles work, repair of furniture and light supply was also completed.
3. Extra toilet facility was provided in the girls common room. Toilet specially for female teachers and employees was also constructed. White washing of all the class rooms, labs, boundary wall was done. Website of the college was upgraded.
4. Repair work of furniture, fans and lights in all the classrooms, labs, office was done. All the old lights were replaced by LED lights to minimize electricity bill. All the damaged electrical and electronics, appliances were written-off and given in scrap.
5. The Green Campus Clean Campus Committee alongwith the volunteers of NSS participated in cleanliness and plantation work in the Campus. A one day camp was organized to plant 500 sapling in the campus. The campus cleaning drive was organized from 1 September to 15 Sept. 2019
6. The NSS Unit organized 07 days camp from 27/11/2019 to 03/12/2019 in village Chorha. The volunteers organized various extension and outreach programmes to sensitize the villagers towards different schemes of state and central Govt. The NSS Cell also organized many competitions on Youth day, Martyrs day, Unity day, International Literacy day and Independence day.
7. The Youth Red Cross volunteers organized a health checkup camp in collaboration with SECL Hospital Dipka on 29/11/2019. The medical team provided the facility of hematological test for anemia, blood group test, free checkup and free medicines to 171 villagers. The volunteers also played Nukkad Natak to aware people against Aids disease. They also donated blood to needy patients throughout the year.
8. The NSS Unit conducted a Workshop from 24/02/2020 to 26/02/2020 in collaboration with NYKS on youth leadership and community development. 04 Students of NSS attended NYKS Inter State Camp from 07/01/2020 to 22/01/2020 at Rawatpura University Raipur.
9. The SVEEP committee conducted many programmes and competitions to sensitize to voters towards their duties in democracy.
10. All the PG departments organized seminars, field work, and departmental activities in their respective departments. DR. M.M. Vaishnav published 05 research papers in the field of Chemistry.
